All students, excluding those from visa waiver countries, are required to obtain a valid entry visa immediately after receiving acceptance notification from this program. School of Engineering will provide assistance for students in obtaining the visa, if requested. It is also mandatory for the students to purchase the medical/travel insurance before their arrival in HK.

Interested parties will be required to submit the online application through the online application system (<u>https://pgservice.seng.ust.hk/summercamp</u>) during <u>6 January -15 March 2020</u>. Selection result will be released by April 2020.
