1. **Period of Dispatch:** Sun 18 August, 2019 – Fri 30 August 2019 (13 days)  
\*Participants are required to register themselves during the daytime of Sun 18 August.
2. **Expected Expenses:**
  - \* NT\$ 8,000 as participation fees
    - These fees cover tuition, accommodation, the cost of materials for workshops, parties, transport expenses of site visits.
    - Pay in cash in New Taiwan Dollars at the Registration during the daytime on 18 August 2019.
  - \* Air tickets must be booked and purchased by participants themselves.
  - \* Participants are required to join the Overseas Travel Insurance and Risk Management Service designated by Tokyo Tech.
3. **Eligibility:**
  - (1) Regular Students (Bachelor's / Master's / Doctoral Courses, regardless their nationality, gender, and year) enrolled at the School of Engineering, School of Materials and Chemical Technology or School of Environment and Society of Tokyo Institute of Technology
  - (2) Students who have a good command of English to take course-works in English
4. **Number to be Admitted:** 20 students
5. **Screening Method:** Examination of Application Form  
\*An interview in English will be held in the case of oversubscription.
