1. What was your most impressive event (lecture, factory visit and cultural program etc.) in this summer program?

I think this is one of the most meaningful summer vacations I have ever spent. Because in this summer program, I with the students from Tokyo Institute of Technology and Taiwan University of Science and Technology has received lectures from outstanding teachers from various disciplines. And the students from Taiwan took us to appreciate the colorful Taiwanese culture, tasted the cuisines of various places, and saw the extraordinary scenery. Every event is very impressive, but the most impressive one is the class given to us by Professor Meng at the National Defense Medical Center. The course is mainly about the preparation of wound dressing material. In class, we learned how to anesthetize the rats, how to remove the back skin of the rats and how to dress the rats with wound dressings material. The reason why I am deeply impressed is because my major is completely unrelated to the medical profession, let alone contact with the experimental mouse. We needed to wear masks, work caps, disposable gloves and protective clothing and to do systemic disinfection before entering the laboratory. This series of actions was very rigorous and necessary. I also asked a lot of questions during the experiment, which benefited me a lot.
