About the university (UPM)

The university I went to called The Technical University of Madrid (UPM), was founded in 1971 as the result of merging different Technical Schools of Engineering and Architecture, originating mainly in the 18th century. Over 35,000 students attend classes during the year. According to the annual university ranking conducted by El Mundo, the Technical University of Madrid ranks as the top technical university in Spain, and second overall. The majority of its Engineering Schools are consistently ranked as leading academic institutions in Spain in their fields, and among the very best in Europe.

UPM's Schools are spread all over Madrid, instead of being placed in a unified campus. They are: University City or Moncloa Campus, Montegancedo Campus, South Campus (Vallecas's Politechnical Complex) and Downtown Campus (Schools inside Madrid's historical center). The campus I went to is Montegancedo campus, it is a 30 minutes bus from the Moncloa campus. Even though it's a little bit far but it is full of nature and green, very beautiful.


About the apartment and life.
